2) The main discussion was regarding our Vision Quest. There was a lively and wide-ranging discussion which yielded interests in several key areas:

- There seemed to be quite a bit of interest in the area of marketing...possible group shows, a group booth at the Saturday Market, workshops by and for our members in various aspects of business and marketing (social media/tech/computer, approaching and dealing with galleries, fairs and festivals, etc.)
- Another area of interest for some would be education –

getting out into the community and the schools. It was felt that we might attract more potters into this endeavor if we offered some training and also more money than we have previously.

- A third suggestion that seemed to draw interest was some kind of Studio Crawl – designed for members to see each others’ workspace and methods.

There was some agreement (not specifically proposed and voted on, but several members seemed to chime in affirmatively) that by establishing small and to-the-point committees, we could accomplish some of these goals without burning out a few members.

The suggestion was made that through the newsletter and/or Survey Monkey we could see how much interest there would be in organizing each of these areas.

The general feeling at the close of the meeting seemed positive, and there was a buzz of excitement in the room.
